To compensate for residual significant impacts to 22.7 ha of Class A condition CHVEF from the Riverview Pit extension area, the **person taking the action** must identify a **direct offset site** that meets requirements of the **EPBC Act Offset Policy**, and secure the offset in perpetuity under a **legally binding agreement** within 12 months from the date of approval of the Offset Strategy at Condition 10.
- 6. To compensate for residual significant impacts to 68.4 ha of breeding and foraging habitat for the Regent Honeyeater, the **person taking the action** must identify a **direct offset site** that meets requirements of the **EPBC Act Offset Policy**, and secure the offset in perpetuity under a **legally binding agreement** within 12 months from the date of approval of the Offset Strategy at Condition 10.
- 7. To compensate for residual significant impacts to 2.6ha of breeding habitat and 102.7 ha of foraging habitat for the Green and Golden Bell Frog, the person taking the action must identify an **offset package** that meets requirements of the **EPBC Act Offset Policy**, and secure a **direct offset site** in perpetuity under a **legally binding agreement** within 12 months from the date of approval of the Offset Strategy at Condition 10.
- 9. The action cannot continue for more than 12 months from the date of approval of the Offset Strategy at Condition 10, unless the **direct offset sites** required by Conditions 5, 6 and 7 have been secured in perpetuity under a **legally binding agreement** by the **person taking the action**.
